
**Craig Dill**, a Daddy, is the current president of the New Mexico Leather Wolves, serves on the Board of the Albuquerque Little Theater and is a member of the Road Runners Car Club. He states, "I am running for this title to give me a platform from which to increase my contribution to the Albuquerque community. The title provides a position from which I could better influence the public perception of the leather/kink/fetish world." Among his goals for this year would be: working to change city ordinances that negatively affect our community, representing New Mexico at leather events outside of the state, competing at International Mr. Leather, and creating more opportunities for the various leather/kink/fetish groups here to interact with each other.

**Jason** is a Dom Switch who is a current pledge to the New Mexico Leather Wolves and had a previous title as "Keeper of the Wrangler Tight Ass" of the Imperial Court of Alaska. He says that the title would, "give me the opportunity to represent the community in a highly positive fashion, continue my selfexamination and obtain personal growth through serving the community. We can keep what we have only by giving it away ... I want to be able to stand up as an example of this loving, welcoming community that does stand together." His goals for a title year include raising awareness of drugs and recovery issues and expanding opportunities for "companionship and camaraderie" outside of bars, play parties and workshops.

**Mistress Sky** held the title of Ms. New Mexico Leather 1998 and is a member of New Mexico Leather League and People Exchanging Power (PEP), and notes that she's "always a Sandia leatherman at heart." She states, "I want to win the title to be a spokeswoman for, to advocate for, and to promote the wellbeing and growth of the BDSM, fetish, and kink community." During a title year she'd work to embrace the "pansexual and pankinkual aspects," become more involved in local groups and find common threads among them. She'd also represent New Mexico in the broader community, competing in another contest at an international level and "seeking outside resources and knowledge that will be beneficial to my personal growth and the growth of our local community."

She is the widow of Sir Robin Niven, a beloved member of the Southwest leather community who



passed away on March 25th, 2007. She lives in Los Angeles, CA. slave Alia is an activist in the Muslim community, championing the causes of religious tolerance and education, the modernisation of Islam, and women's rights in Islam. She has been in service to Master Skip since November 19th of 2003.

Jeff Tucker lives in San Jose, CA with his new husband Steve Crane; they were legally married on October 5, 2008 and have actually been partners for over 19 years, and his 26 year old daughter Maryah. Competing as Mr. San Jose Leather, he became International Mr. Leather in 1994. As IML, Jeff created "Better Together" - a program to honor ourselves and the diversity of the Leather Community. He was a cofounder of the Santa Clara County Leather Association and the creator of "SM Tasting," an education program for BDSM, and D/s interests for the beginner through the advanced players. Jeff is also a charter member of



The Brotherhood, a private gay men's leather and BDSM group. He has been participating in the BDSM, and D/s lifestyle for almost 30 years. His greatest challenge and reward has come from his spiritual journey; he is an ordained minister. Jeff believes that the highest values of a person are authenticity and integrity. He credits his family, his incredible friends, his extended leather family, and the copious individuals and events he has encountered in his life for the joy and bliss he experiences daily.

They have attended several M/s and D/s events as well as competitions.

Jack McGeorge is a het male dominant with a passion for bondage and a long-held interest in the dynamics of Master/slave relationships. Currently, Jack serves as Chairman of the board of CARAS (Community-Academic Consortium for Research on Alternative Sexualities). He is a founding member of Black Rose and an emeritus member of its board of directors. Previously he served Black Rose in several capacities including Chairman of the Board, President, Secretary and Co-chair for BR10. He is also an emeritus member of the, Leather Leadership Conference board and served as its Vice Chairman and Treasurer as well as Co-chair for LLC2000. Jack



was also the first Chairman of the Board of NCSF. Jack and slave raven were the North East Regional Master and slave for 2005. Jack is the recipient of several awards including: a Community Service Award from GMSMA (2006); the Man Of The Year Award (2004) and two Community Service Awards (2000 and 1998) from the Pantheon of Leather; the Pat Bond Community Service Award from The Eulenspiegel Society (2003); both the Elder Award (2000) and the Vaughn Keith National Education Award (1998) from Black Rose and the Centurion Award (2000) from Joseph Bean and the Leather Archives and Museum. He was also the first to be designated an Anthony DeBlase Professor of the Arts and Letters of S/M (1999) by Leather University.

**Daddy Bear Keli** is Ms. RGL 08. Keli and eve are an Albuquerque-based 24/7 Master/slave couple transplanted from Florida three years ago. Keli enjoys the concepts of training to serve, and serving through representation; the idea that all acts are acts of service, not just the ones that the Master is aware of. Keli is extremely proud of her beautiful and talented slave eve. eve has done everything this year from organize the fundraisers to keeping the house on track. Both Keli and eve are extremely grateful for their opportunity to serve the community. They feel this experience is something that will stay with them for a very long time, and wish the best to the new titleholders. Have a great year! In February of 2006 a curious and somewhat apprehensive young man attended his first NM:TNG meeting and to his surprise, he found himself thrown into a group of people which he found to be goofy, fun and personable. Over the next month, he continued his research of "the lifestyle" and dove in head first at his next meeting. Within a few months this young man was given the name/ title of crrreature and he found himself actively volunteering, demo-bottoming and exploring alternative lifestyles in ways he hadn't expected. Two years later we find that this same young man has co-founded and is establishing the Leather Scouts, he is a coalition partner representative and avid fundraiser for the NCSF, and he is an educator and somewhat infamous player. He has served the community for the past year as Mr Rio Grande Leather 2008 in a myriad of ways including teaching at a variety of venues, performing both locally and regionally, serving with the organizational committee for Spring Pandemonium and as the Sqt. at Arms for the NM:TNG Board. (Not to mention that his passion for medical and blood play has raised more than one eyebrow here in New Mexico and beyond.) This is a challenging ride to say the least, what with all of the above, school, work and being a dad; but with crrreature's constant thoughts of the future, it will certainly stay nice and exciting.

Alexis Blizman moved to Albuquerque in August 2005 to take the position of Executive Director of Equality New Mexico. During her tenure, Alexis increased EQNM's visibility in the LGBT community, increased the list of supporters by 10,000 people, led LGBT Get Out the Vote programs during elections, and helped write and introduce comprehensive domestic partnership legislation in the NM Legislature. Working with the LGBT and ally communities to



organize constituents and lobby in the Roundhouse, Alexis helped bring the Domestic Partner legislation within one vote of passage, and helped develop an electoral and legislative plan to pass this legislation in 2009. Alexis left her position with Equality New Mexico in September of 2008. While earning her BA in Political Science in Detroit, she became President of the Wayne State Young Democrats and became active in paid and volunteer work on local, state, and national campaigns. In 1993 she helped to found the GLBT Caucus of the Young Democrats and in 1994 helped to get the caucus full voting rights. While in law school she served as the Director of Graduate Affairs of the Student Bar Association and the Chair of the Law School's chapter of Lambda Law. In 1999, she became the first openly gay Democratic National Committeewoman elected by the Young Democrats of America. In 2003, Alexis joined the Law Offices of Brian J. Moran in Alexandria VA as an associate attorney where she worked in Domestic Relations, Civil Litigation, Criminal and Business Law. During this time, Alexis remained committed to the political process, volunteering on several campaigns, working with GAYLAW, and continuing to serve the Young Democrats of America as their General Counsel.




#### Keynote Address, "Living the Journey of your Leather Heart"

Leather is a society as diverse as the mainstream itself – perhaps even more so. This is not to say Leather is without leaders or heritage; it is rich in both.





5-11:15am The Art of Boot Blacking and Leather Care, Cristo, Room 135 Bootblacks have become such an essential part of our leather community and history. If you are a Bootblack or have interest in being a bootblack or simply doing it as a form of service, this class covers a wide variety of skills and levels.of this wonderful and much needed art in our community. This is a hands-on class learning the skills of boot blacking and how to take care of your toys. Supplies will be provided. Bring a pair of boots or leather toy if you would like to learn tricks of the trade during this class.

This is a very hands-on class that can get messy. This class will break down into three parts, depending on the needs of the class

- 1. History of Boot Blacking in The Leather Community / Erotic Boot Blacking & Boot Worship / The Boot Black Community Movement.
- Boot Blacking Skills / Leather Care Skills: Learn how to take care of leathers, toys and having them look their best. Learning to recognize different types of leather and non leather items and how to care for them. This portion of the class we will discuss how to care for garments such as leather jackets, chaps, etc. as well as play toys and single tails.
- 3. Spit Shines and Boot Repair: This is for the advanced portion of the class. How to get the best spit shine and how to repair cuts and gouges in your boots. Both of these techniques are time consuming so if time does not allow this portion can be taught after lunch upon request.

#### Serving from a Place of Power and Authority, The Marine, Emerald

This workshop is focused on being in service to the vision and greater good of the Dominant and the relationship you share. We will talk about a willingness to make decisions within the parameters of the Master's desire to create a positive outcome.

#### Mental Dominance, Master David Walker, Sandia

This presentation is about how to use dominance to define yourself and create your immediate reality. It has been said that "Dominance is in your head, but no one tells you where in your head." This course answers that question. Want to build a lasting relationship, a family, a community, or a world? This is the starting place. This is a course open to both Tops and bottoms.

# Standing In the Midst of Madness: SM, D/s, and Our Histories of Abuse, slave alia, Crystal

Many men and women alike have experienced some form of prolonged abuse or violence. Yet many of us are drawn to SM and D/s either despite, or because of, this earlier "programming." In this workshop we will discuss 1) how we can learn to accept that we are drawn to SM and D/s regardless of what baggage we carry; 2) how our behavior in our SM or D/s relationships might be directly or indirectly related to our victim/survivor "programming;" 3) ways in which one can "reset" the program or at least look at it in a new and constructive light. This workshop is most helpful for anyone who is a survivor of abuse, is active or interested in being active in the BDSM lifestyle, and it will be especially useful for Tops/Dominants/Masters who are (or might be) in a D/s relationship with a bottom/submissive/slave who is a survivor of abuse.

Odaxelagnia – The fetish of biting or being bitten. A sometimes misunderstood but widely practiced fetish. We will explore the historical evolution of biting as it has appeared in religious text, folklore and literature. The majority of the class will be spent in a roundtable demonstration format, discussing technique, practice, application and safety. There will be plenty of opportunity to learn and share your ideas about this fetish, from its simplest forms to more complex and animistic/ritualistic concepts. With today's restrictions on travel, this is an "Unarmed" fetish play that can be applied with little or no extraneous tools or toys, making it very easy and fun to explore the more wild and animal needs of your partner(s) or playmates.

#### One Size Does Not Fit All, Malik and slave cathy, Sandia

What happens when we want to change what is not in the blueprints? As children we try to put a square peg in a round hole and learn it is not always easy or right. As adults, we still try to put things into our lives that might not fit in the eyes of other people. If you're concerned about "fitting in" because your ideology of M/s and D/s relationships are not what others think or believe, this class is for you. Our presenters will discuss the concerns and controversy that comes when Master/slave and Dominant/submissive couples do not conform to a "norm" of actions or protocols that others have set. Variety is a key factor to manage and optimize the success of the relationship. Whatever rituals, greetings, tasks, service or play you engage in with your partner, diversity must exist to allow for growth and ideal execution of your relationship goals.

# The Roles of Customs, Decorum, Rituals and Ceremony in Master/slave Relationships, Jack McGeorge, Crystal

The body of customs we adhere to both constitute the reality of consensual slavery and differentiate it from otherwise similar vanilla activities. The consistent practice of certain customary behaviors concerning decorum, ritual and ceremony are both the meat and potatoes of slavery and necessary for the survival of the relationship. Jack will both discuss the theory and share specific examples of how these concepts are put into daily practice within the Order for Discipline and Service.

**Dave Rhodes** is the publisher and editor of *The Leather Journal* which was founded in 1987, is president of the Pantheon of Leather Community Service Awards which he founded in 1991, and is founder of the Mr. and Ms. Olympus Leather Contest which takes place during Pantheon of Leather. He created A Living Leather History which is a now a huge work-in-progress on www.LeatherJournal.com He has received



several honors including Pantheon of Leather Man of the Year Award in 2001 and 2007, the Southland Honors' Business of the Year in 2004 presented by the LA Leather Coalition, National Gay and Lesbian Task Force's 2006 Creating Change Award, and the Media Award by Christopher Street West in 2006.

David Riehl and Wolf Pup Wielder founded the Lone Star Rubber Corps (www. Isrubber.net), a social club for gay rubbermen inter-

ested in rubber and latex wear and gear for fetish and play. From rubber jeans to diving suits to hip boots to bondage gear, the rubber world encompasses a wide range of fetishes. We are based in Texas and the Southwest but are inclusive to all. We promote the rubber lifestyle through demos, rubber socials, play, wearing of rubber in public venues and sharing information on rubber wear and care. We encourage the curious and the novice alike in their exploration of the rubber lifestyle. 




